Parade, pie and play hit Harrington

HARRINGTON — The Harrington Fall Festival returns Saturday, Sept. 27, bringing a full day of community traditions, food, games and fun for all ages.

The celebration kicks off early with the FFA Pancake Feed at Memorial Hall from 8 to 10 a.m. and the Huff 'N Puff Fun Run at 9 a.m. The annual parade will march through town beginning at 11 a.m.

Throughout the day, visitors can tour the Opera House rummage sale from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., browse the library book sale from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., and explore historic sites such as the Electric Hotel, open from 10 a.m. to noon, and the Wagner Building, which opens at 3 p.m.

At the city park, festivities include the Homemakers Pie Sale

at noon, vendors from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., and the Lions Club barbecue lunch beginning at 11:30 a.m. Alumni will gather from noon to 3 p.m. while kids can enjoy carnival games and a dunk tank during the same hours. Bingo runs from 1 to 3 p.m., and the raffle drawing will wrap up the afternoon at 3 p.m.

also be open, including Harrington Foods, Harrington Haus, Harrington Tattoo, The Mercantile, The Post & Office and Home & Makers.

Festival organizers encourage residents and visitors alike to come out, enjoy the lineup and celebrate Harrington's community spirit.



Longtime Harrington couple named marshals

Picked for longtime contributions

HARRINGTON — Few families have been more deeply woven into the Harrington community than LaMarr and Susan Haugan Larmer, and this fall they will lead the town's annual celebration as the 2025 Harrington Fall Festival Grand Marshals.

LaMarr and Susan, graduates of the Harrington School in 1977 and 1980 respectively, each spent their entire K-12 education in the district before attending Washington State University. After marrying, they returned to their hometown to raise a family and build their careers.



In 1983, LaMarr was hired to teach third grade in Harrington and went on to spend the next 42 years instructing second through

sixth grades while also coaching high school tennis, football, middle school basketball and baseball, and Biddy Basketball. Generations of students passed through his classroom and athletic programs.

Susan was a stay-at-home mother until 1997, when she began teaching preschool in Harrington. She held the position for 27 years until her retirement at the close of the 2024-25 school year.

The couple's three children are also Harrington alumni, making them the third generation of the family to graduate from the district.

LaMarr and Susan retired from Harrington schools this year, leaving behind what community members describe as a legacy of dedication and service.

"We are both very humbled and honored to be selected as the Grand Marshals for the Fall Festival parade. The way we look at it is as us volunteering for us to help out with the community," said LaMarr. "We don't expect any accolades because we are here to serve others. That is our purpose. To serve others and the groups in town. We just want to continue to be able to help out where we can. We don't expect payment. We expect to help and make things better."

The Harrington Fall Festival will take place Saturday, Sept. 27, featuring a parade, fun run, pancake breakfast, kids' activities, vendors and more.





