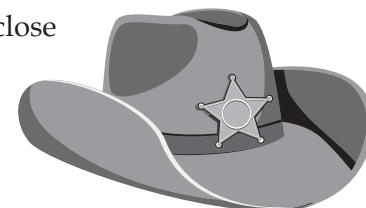

# Vendors are set for county fair

*Food, informational booths, goods all offered*

DAVENPORT — Visitors to the Lincoln County Fair and Rodeo will have a wide variety of shopping and dining options during the annual event, which runs Wednesday, August 20, through Sunday, August 24.

Vendors will be located throughout the fairgrounds, including the dining hall, Grange Building, midway and food court.

Scentsy with Ginny Palmer will offer wax melts, warmers, dif-

fusers, oils, body products, cleaning products and laundry items. The Lavender Cow will sell sweat-shirts, T-shirts, hats, tumblers and mugs decorated with transfers.

In the Grange Building, Renewal by Andersen will provide information on residential window and door replacement, along with free entry into a \$25,000 window makeover giveaway and complimentary consultations. Washington State Patrol representatives will be on-site to support recruiting efforts. Author Byrne Bennett of "A Greater Destiny" will be present, and The Gideons International will distribute informational materials.

Midway vendors will include Serrano Sales, which will offer face painting, kids' and hair accessories and cooling towels. Mark Everything will feature sunglasses, children's toys and miscellaneous items including commercial knives. Paletas La Norteña will sell light-up toys, stuffed animals, children's clothing, mini cars and more.

Food and drink vendors will include Huckleberry Scopes, which will serve hard scoop ice cream, floats and huckleberry lemonade. O'Houlis Kettle Corn will offer kettle corn and freshly squeezed lemonade. Egg Roll Express & Teriyaki will provide

fried rice, yaki soba noodles, grilled chicken teriyaki, tempura chicken and egg rolls. Eastern Coffee Roasters will offer hot and iced coffee, Italian sodas, energy drinks, cookies, muffins and cake pops.

Brain Freeze Ice Cream Truck will feature prepackaged frozen treats. Paletas La Norteña will also serve Mexican food, snow cones, Red Bulls, Lotus drinks, burgers, hot dogs, boba tea, soda, horchata and breakfast items. The Davenport High School FBLA will sell burgers, hot dogs, sausages, chili and French fries as part of a student fundraiser.

Three musical performances are scheduled during the event, bringing a variety of country, folk and indie-inspired sounds to the fairgrounds.

## Hawk Creek Band – Friday, Aug. 22

Kicking off the live music lineup, Hawk Creek Band will take the outdoor stage from 3 p.m.

to 7 p.m. on Friday, August 22. The band features original indie-folk music that blends numerous musical influences, aiming to tell stories that are “entertaining, meaningful and hopeful.”

Band members include Randy Beamer (vocals, acoustic and electric guitar), Lynn Caddell (vocals, guitar), Dennis Birge (drums, percussion), and Steve Hancock (bass, background vocals).

From 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Saturday, August 23, Bonnie and The Extras will perform on the outdoor stage. Originally founded by Bonnie Campbell and her husband Clint, the band has evolved over

the past decade into a genre-blending group with roots in bluegrass, classic country and 90s hits.

The group includes Pat Estes on bass, Thad Striffler on piano and drums, Deanna Dammel on the jimbe drum, and Wayne Mahrholz on guitar.

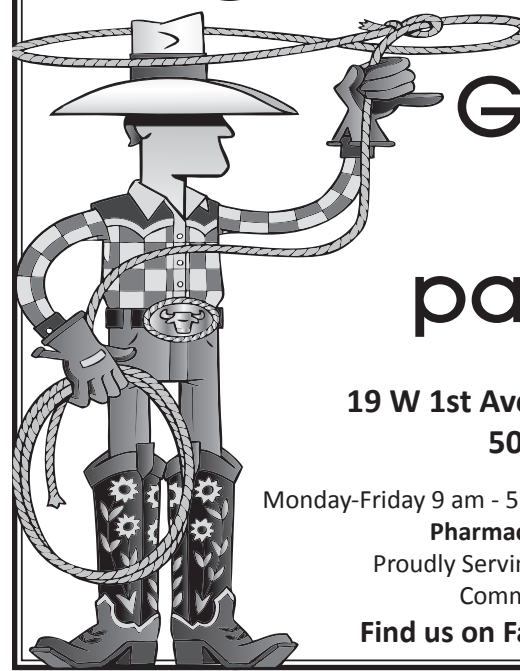
